



Guidelines for Concordia College Courts – Home courts for St John's Lutheran Netball Club (SJLNC) and shared with Rosefield Uniting Netball Club.

If you have a fever, cough, sore throat or shortness of breath please do not attend. We encourage you to get tested even if your symptoms are mild and isolate until you have your results.

If you have visited an area of a known Covid-19 outbreak, you must get tested and isolate.

Players and Spectators will be required to check in at Concordia College Courts using our QR Code. Our Court Supervisor will be checking compliance.

If you do not have a smart phone, you will be required to complete a "back up" tracing sheet. This will be available from the Court Supervisor, and will then be kept securely by SJLNC for 28 days.

To help with contact tracing please consider downloading the COVIDSafe app.

SJLNC has a Court Supervisor who is responsible for outlining protocols, reminding of social distancing and to generally give guidance where necessary.

Supervisor will carry a copy of our Covid Safe Plan, is First Aid trained, and will happily answer any questions you may have regarding the venue.

**Key points at Concordia College Courts:**

- Physical distancing (1.5m separation) to be maintained where possible by all spectators. Our Court Supervisor will be reminding attendees of this requirement.
- Our venue has a maximum of 1000 people on site. We encourage spectators to be aware of this limit, and ask, where possible, that spectators be limited to 2 per player.
- Spectators will be allowed inside the court area during the minor round, provided this limit and social distancing is adhered to. Please ensure Coaches and Officials are not impacted by positioning of spectators. Spectators must move if requested by the Court Supervisor or Officials.
- Please be aware of where congestion may occur: i.e. at entry and exit points and upon leaving the court area - and avoid as able. There will be signage regarding the match fixture and court allocations on all entry/exit gates. Please use the gate closest to your court to avoid congestion. The Court Supervisor will also carry a copy of the fixture and provide guidance for players and spectators.
- All players and officials must apply hand sanitiser provided at the gate - before entering the court area and upon exiting the court area.
- Teams may warm up on the oval opposite the courts, but are not permitted to enter the court area until the players and officials in the timeslot before them have exited. Please do not arrive more than 30 min prior to the commencement of your match.
- Teams should have sanitizer and wipes in their team kit bags for all players to use. All first aid kits should include sanitizer, wipes and gloves.
- Umpires - no sharing of whistles. A "hand whistle" will be held by the Court Supervisor, should it be required.
- Discourage communal food and drink during training and matches – e.g. avoid oranges at half time. Players may wish to bring an extra water bottle/juice/own fruit. Please do not share drink bottles. There is a drinking fountain available at the courts for filling of bottles.
- Players to have an alternative to handshakes at the end of each game.
- Pole covers are to be wiped down after each game. There are wipes in each kit. Officials to assist with this please.
- Team manager/coach to regularly wash bibs.
- Toilets are available at Concordia College – St John's Campus – in the red building to the east of the court area. Physical distancing should be observed. Court Supervisor to monitor St John's Campus toilets and ensure disinfection of touchpoints – as well as running water, adequate soap, and paper towels.
