## Home Court COVID-19 Procedures at Rosefield Uniting Church Courts

This document uses information and advice from SAUCNA, Rosefield Uniting Church and COVID-19 requirements as directed by Government Regulations. The information is current as of 27th May 2021, but is subject to change. Please do not attend the courts if you are unwell.

### Parking

Attendees may park on the street or in the church car park on the opposite side of Carlton Street. There is only one access point to the courts so patrons will need to stand clear of the gate to minimise crowding. The car park on the church premises will be closed for safety purposes.

### QR Check-in

Everyone attending the courts needs to complete contact tracing records, including children. This can be with the QR code or the manual sign-in sheet at the gate for attendees without smartphones. Players may use the QR code. If a team prefers to use their own team sign-in sheet, please hand it to the supervisor after the game. Sign-in sheets for teams are also available from the Covid marshal at the gate. Patrons must remain 1.5m apart.

### Players, coaches and officials

All players, coaches and officials will be required to remain in the area close to the courts. Players not on court will need to sit as close to the court as practicable and remain there during game time. Coaches may only coach from the designated coaching boxes.

### Spectators

There are 2 areas for spectators at Rosefield Courts.

- Inside the fenced off court area, underneath the pergola. This can only be used by spectators watching the north court game and patrons must stand behind the marked line.
- The car park area. This will be closed to traffic (except vehicles with appropriate disability parking permits) and reserved for patrons. All spectators watching the south court game will be required to stand here.

The maximum number of spectators allowed will be determined by the Rosefield Netball Club Covid safe plan, and may change. The number allowed does not include players and officials. The plan and number of spectators permitted will be posted at the church for reference. Chairs will only be provided for the scorers.

### Timing

Games will be centrally timed, with the exception of some 12 o'clock times. These may need to be individually timed as there may be 2 different age groups with different playing conditions. The court supervisor/covid marshal will advise.

### Court Supervisor/Covid Marshal

There will be a COVID-19 marshal present at the courts to ensure all rules and recommendations are adhered to. Please respect their direction. A second supervisor will be present for the purpose of umpire mentoring and game management as required and may also direct patrons.

### COVID-19 Requirements

- Do not arrive more than 20 minutes before the game and leave the game promptly.
- Do not share drink bottles, oranges, lollies or other food.
- Use an alternative to a handshake at the end of a game.
- Sanitiser will be made available at the courts and in all Rosefield first aid kits.
- The match ball for the second half will be kept by the scorer.
- Pole covers and chairs will be wiped down after each game by the Supervisor.
- A copy of the Rosefield netball Club COVID stage 3 plan is available.
