## **Match Procedures at Cabra College and WPPS courts**

### **COVID -19 for Clubs 2022**

#### **GOVERNMENT:**

Follow all Government and ORSR Guidelines for Netball Community Sport levels and SA Health COVID plans.

#### **COVID-TRACING**

QR Code check in by mobile phone (including adding additional family members) and physical tracing records available.

#### **COVID-PLANS**

- WPUCNC have COVID Safe plans and COVID-Safe Check-in QR codes for both Cabra and WPPS sites.
- Court areas are fenced zones for netball matches: Players and Officials only.
- No Spectators allowed courtside\*.  
Spectators to remain outside fence zone at venues with of **one caregiver per participant**.
- Home Court Supervisors (COVID Marshal) present at venues. Please respect their directions.

#### **WPUCNC OUTDOOR MATCHES:**

- All community netball participants **MUST NOT attend netball environment if they are UNWELL or symptomatic**.
- Court venue access **ONLY from 11.45pm**. Schools have access till 11.30pm with sport.
- **All patrons (includes every family member, officials, and players) must have contact tracing records; either QR code check in or fill out tracing records available at table as directed for Sporting Clubs in COVID Safe-plans.**
- **Only one spectator per player allowed at our venues.**  
This is due to our Home Court Supervisor having COVID Marshal responsibilities requiring venue <200 patrons at each time slot and to allow for varied match number allocation weekly and for 1.5m distance for patrons.
- **Access to court zones:** Players and Officials and WPUCNC Club Officials.  
Each court: 2 club umpires, 2 teams with each team having up to 10 players; Coach; Scorer; Manager/Timer, Primary Carer. Spectators must remain outside the fenced courts\*.
- Matches scheduled with no grace period: 12.00pm, 1.45pm, 3.30pm.
- Arrival 15 minutes prior to match to allow for match turnover and abide by social distancing rules.  
i.e- 'Get in and get out' philosophy.
- **Individual court timing of matches by home and away teams**
  - 15 minutes quarters by home team with 3', 5', 3' breaks by away team.
- Safe physical distancing of at least 1.5m separation practiced by all in every area.
- Teams should provide own first aid and sanitizer for game, however sanitization stations will be available on entry.
- Access to shared facility toilets. Other sporting events may be on Cabra site.  
No change room /shower access or gym area (Cabra gym via toilets is alarmed).
- Recommend teams sanitize equipment after match.
- No shared water bottles. Recommend water bottles be labelled.
- No communal food and drink during training and matches, eg avoid oranges at half time, lollies etc.

*\*Exception: Only access to courts by spectators is if the Cabra 4<sup>th</sup> court is used (court 4) - spectators observing that match may use court 3 for access/safety.*
