

SAUCNA – How can I be involved?

SAUCNA Appointed Officers

12 month positions, commencing November each year

The positions of Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer are appointed by the Executive Committee each November.

Applications for these positions must be submitted, in writing, and countersigned by the applicant's Club Secretary.

All applications must be forwarded to the Association Secretary by 31st October each year.

SAUCNA Elected Officers

12 month positions commencing at the AGM (February) each year

Nominations for the positions of President, Vice-Presidents (2), and committee members (7) are to be submitted, in writing to the Association Secretary and be received at least eight (8) days prior to the Annual General Meeting in February of each year.

Nominations must be made by the nominee's Club Secretary, be seconded by a member of **another club**, and finally signed by the nominee to show acceptance of the nomination.

Each club may have only one (1) representative on the Executive Committee, unless that club fielded five (5) or more teams in the previous Winter competition, in which case the club may have two representatives.

SAUCNA Executive Committee meets on the 1st Monday of each month throughout the year.

Summer Executive Committee

12 month positions commencing at the Summer AGM (September) each year

Nominations for the positions of Chairman, Deputy Chairman, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, and a maximum of eight (8) committee persons shall be called for. The election of these positions takes place at the Summer Annual General Meeting in September of each year.

Each club may have a maximum of two (2) representatives on the Executive Committee, Summer Section.

The Chairman and Deputy Chairman may not hold their positions for more than five (5) successive years.

Umpires Committee

12 month positions commencing 1st January each year

Nominations for the positions of Chairman, Deputy Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, and a maximum of eight (8) committee persons shall be called for. Nominations shall be in writing signed by a proposer and a seconder who are each members of the Association. The nominee will sign the nomination as an indication that they are willing to act in the nominated position and they will identify the club which they represent or that they are an independent umpire. The nomination must be delivered to the Secretary of the Umpires Committee at least eight (8) days prior to the date of the Annual General Meeting of the Umpires Association.

The Umpires Committee consists of the elected executive and general committee members all of whom are, or have been, netball umpires. Not more than one representative of any club and not more than three independent umpires shall be elected, appointed or co-opted to the Umpires Committee.

The election of these positions takes place at the Umpires Annual General Meeting in August of each year.

Coaching, Managing & Umpiring

Each year the Association sends representative teams to the Combined Australian Netball Association National Championships. Nominations for the positions of coach, manager and umpire are due for submission in late April each year.
