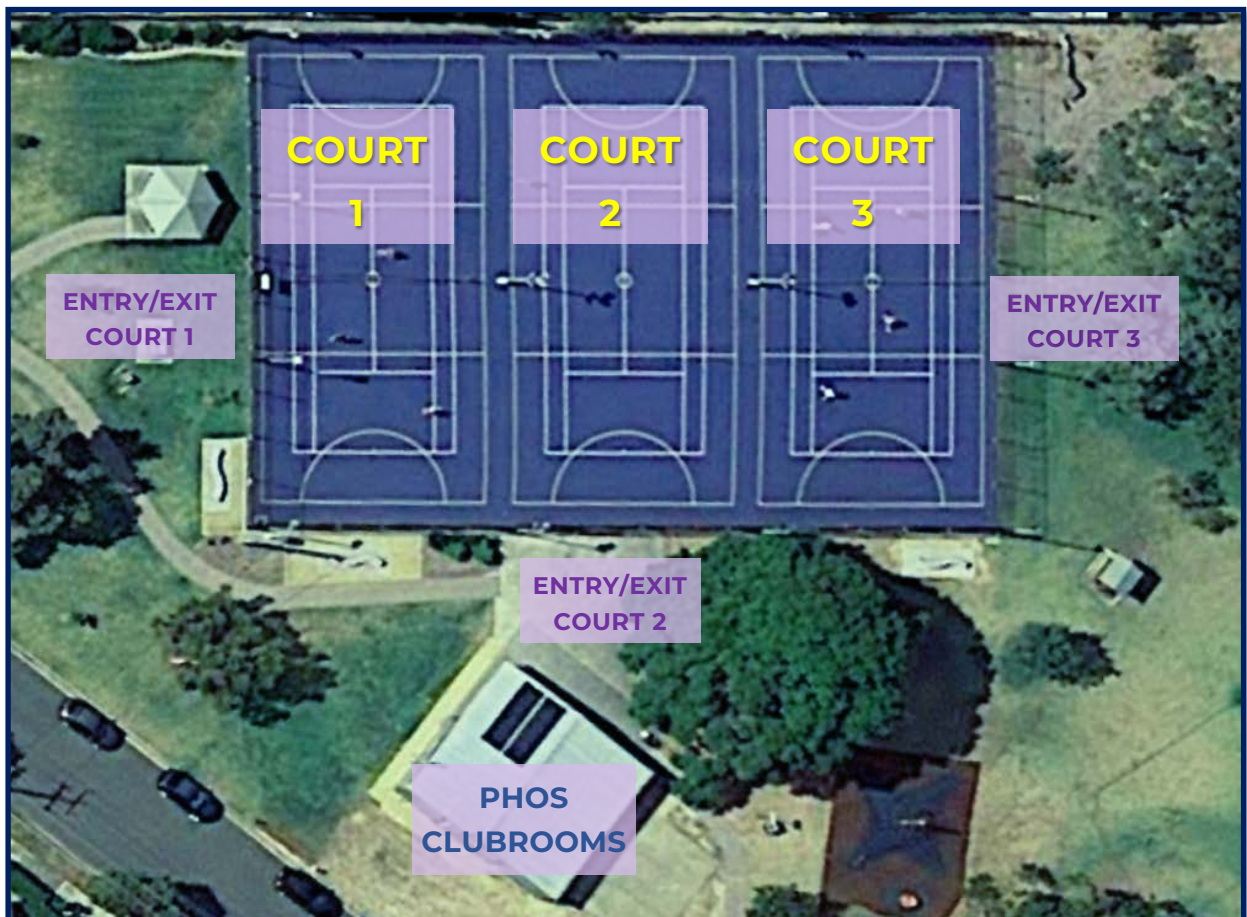
PHOS NETBALL CLUB HOME COURTS COVID-19 GUIDELINES

These guidelines have been developed in conjunction with the COVID-Safe Plan for our home netball games. A copy of our COVID-Safe Plan is located in our clubrooms and can be viewed there if required. A PHOS Netball Club COVID Marshal will be in attendance at home games, wearing a pink vest to ensure all restrictions are adhered to by everyone. This includes making sure that people enter and exit the venue correctly, there is safe physical distancing practiced by all in every area and once a game finishes people leave court area immediately. Please direct any queries to them.

PHOS Netball Club is located at Aroona Ave, Glenelg North. We have 3 courts which will be numbered as per the map below. Each court has its own entry and exit gate which must be used for both teams and officials on that court. These are shown in the map and are as follows:

- Court 1 - Enter via the western side, closest to the road
- Court 2 - Enter via the main gates on the southern side
- Court 3 - Enter via eastern side, closest to the oval

We will also be using courts at Immanuel College for some of our home games. There will be a COVID Marshal there as well as tracing forms, sanitiser and wipes/spray for the poles.



The following guidelines must be adhered to at the PHOS home courts.

- Everyone attending the facilities must COVID SAfe Check-In upon arrival using the QR codes at the clubrooms. The QR code is on the window and door of the clubrooms, the fences near the gates and on the COVID Tracing form for teams to use.
- Coaches must complete the COVID Tracing form for their team and handed to the COVID Marshal immediately after the game. If you are in attendance at the game, you are responsible for ensuring you are listed on the COVID Tracing Form. There will also be a form either inside or outside on a table (depending on weather) for umpires and officials that aren't part of a team. Blank forms will be available at the clubrooms but we do prefer you bring one to the game to avoid any unnecessary traffic in the clubrooms
- All personnel must practise good hygiene. Hand sanitiser will be available at each entry/exit gate and must be applied before entry and when exiting. This includes the courts at Immanuel. Each coach must have hand sanitiser in their team bags along with first aid kits including instant cold packs. Ice or frozen ice packs will not be available from the clubrooms.
- Teams must not enter the court until all teams from the previous time slot have left the court. Do not arrive more than 30 minutes before your game starts. Please ensure your teams leave the courts immediately following the game and all match personnel, spectators etc. leave the grounds promptly.
- The maximum number of people per court inside the fenced area is 2 teams (7 players per team), 2 umpires and 2 coaches. This includes during the breaks. Team managers, substitute players, timers, scorers and spectators must be located outside the fence. Do not congregate outside or near the entry/exit gates and the gates must be kept clear for player movements. There is to be a maximum of 2 spectators per player with the total number of persons present not exceeding 3 people per 4 sq metres. All personnel including spectators and officials must keep to the 1.5m social distancing rule.
- The chairs in the clubrooms are not to be used or removed from the clubrooms. We would prefer you didn't use the benches and they must be wiped down if used. Wipes will be available near the hand sanitiser. All timers, scorekeepers and spectators must bring their own chairs.
- Players are not to bring fruit to share but their own if necessary. Lollies may be given out following the game, only if they are individually wrapped. Players are not to use the bubblers at the grounds or share drink bottles. Following the game, there is to be no hand shaking, using an alternative to avoid touching.
- Following the game, the pole covers must be wiped down or sprayed by the PHOS coach (wipes and spray is located outside the court with the hand sanitiser).
- There will be 2 match balls, inspected by the umpires prior to the games with one ball kept by the scorers for the second half. Do not remove this ball or allow other players, brothers, sisters etc to use it.
- Toilets are open, but are for emergency use only. They should go before they come!! Please use hand sanitiser before entry to the clubrooms and wash your hands thoroughly for at least 20 seconds after using the toilet.
- Do not visit if you have any of the following symptoms: cough, shortness of breath, fever, runny nose, sore throat, aches & pains, are generally feeling unwell (even if only mild), or been in close-contact to a person with COVID-19 in the preceding 14 days.

Everyone has a role to play in helping stopping the spread of COVID-19. Through abiding by these guidelines, in line with government recommendations we aim to keep community sport in South Australia safe and COVID-19 free. Failure to abide may result in costly fines and more importantly risk the safety of ourselves and the wider community.
