



COVID SAFE GUIDELINES for Matches at HALLETT COVE NETBALL CLUB - WINTER 2021

This set of guidelines has been developed in conjunction with the club's COVID-Safe Plan for our home netball courts.

The maximum number of members of the public **must not exceed current density requirements** as per SA Government restrictions.

1.5 metres social distancing must be maintained and encouraged at all times.

COVID MARSHAL will be present at all times. Please comply with all requests and instructions.

All Attending **MUST** check in, either through QR code or written documentation, this includes all players (of all ages), team officials, spectators and siblings.

- **SPECTATORS MUST BE KEPT TO A MINIMUM**, ensuring social distancing is maintained at all times
- Do not enter the court area more than 30 minutes before start of match, ensuring that cleaning of courts has been completed before entering – COVID Marshal will signal when entry is permitted
- Sanitise on entry/exit to the courts
- Vacate courts within 10 minutes of your match being completed, ensuring all rubbish, drink bottles, jumpers, balls, etc are taken with you
- Side gate will be open for exiting courts to help reduce congestion at gates
- Team benches to be established on either side of the scoring shed for each court
- Players to remain on their allocated court, they are not permitted to warm up on another court
- All spectators must be on the sideline opposite to the scoring shed
- Only team officials permitted in scoring shed, ensuring social distancing is maintained at all times
- All siblings must be supervised and remain with their parent at all times

OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

- Team shared food is still considered communal food and is discouraged – NO oranges or lollies
- NO sharing of drink bottles – recommend all drink bottles be labelled
- Players must come with adequate water – bottles are not permitted to be filled up at the canteen
- Handshakes and any unnecessary contact are not recommended
