### Home Court Procedures

Morialta Uniting Church (MC) and Penfold Park (PP)

These procedures incorporate standard operating procedures for both venues, SAUCNA recommendations and COVID-19 safety conditions in line with SA Government Regulations.

#### Parking

- Please note that parking at both venues is limited. Please be respectful of all other cars and local residents when parking your car.

#### Court Access

- Access to the MU courts is for players, umpires and team officials (coach, manager and scorer) only. The timekeeper for the quarters may be inside the court area if space is available. **NO SPECTATORS** are permitted inside the fenced courts **for any reason at any time**. The Morialta court supervisor and umpire mentor are the only additional persons permitted inside the fenced area.
- The PP courts are located in a public park area. Spectators should distance themselves from the courts allowing team officials closest position to the court area.

#### Spectators

- The number of spectators permitted is determined through the current Government regulations relating to public places.
- The spectator area at MU courts is between the fenced court area and the canteen shed and is 269m<sup>2</sup>.
- At the PP courts we have estimated an area around the court space of 300m<sup>2</sup> for spectators at an adequate viewing position.
- To ensure that we stay below the maximum number of spectators we request that no more than 2 spectators per player attend the matches at either venue where possible.

#### Amenities

- A canteen will be available at MU however no BBQ will be available until further notice.
- Toilets are available at both venues however everyone needs to be mindful of the space available. At MU no more than 2 people should be in the toilet area at any time.

#### COVID-19 Requirements

- Do not arrive more than 20 minutes before commencement of the match.
- Check in using supplied Morialta Netball Club QR code or manual form. The manual form must be handed to the Morialta Team manager/court supervisor prior to leaving the venue.
- Use hand sanitizer prior to entry to the courts (available hanging from the fence near the gate)
- Teams should have sanitizer in their team bags for all players to use.
- Players not to share drink bottles. Please ensure they are labelled appropriately.
- Have an alternative to handshakes at the end of each game
- Teams to leave quickly after each game
- Pole covers and chairs to wiped down after each game.
- Umpires no sharing of whistles.
- The match ball for the second half, once approved by the umpires, is to be kept by the scorers.
- All first aid kits should include sanitizer, wipes and gloves.
